




# Make-up of gut microbiome may influence COVID-



In this approach, craft supplies partnered with disposable lab tools can be used to teach fundamental lab skills safely at home! The three "Microbiome Mamas" developed a total of 9 exercises to teach the basic ASM microbiology laboratory skills:

- Aseptic technique and Proper personal protective equipment (PPE) removal,
- Microscopy and stains
- Streaking for single isolates, plating a lawn, and serial dilution, antibiotic resistance assays
- Inoculating media, modeling disease spread, and filtering microbes.
